#### **New UHS Dedication**

On Sunday, April 22, 2018 at 2:00p.m. the Urbana City School District will celebrate the completion of the construction of our new high school by holding a dedication and ribbon cutting ceremony.

This new facility, built behind the current school, will provide our students a modern and flexible learning environment for many years to come. The new Urbana High School replaces the historic structure commonly know as the 'Castle' which has been serving the community since 1897. This facility is a collaboration of the entire Urbana community and is designed to meet the current and future needs of our students.

The ceremony is open to the public and will be followed by building tours and light refreshments. The current high school will also be open after the ceremony for those interested in seeing the building prior to demolition activities.

# **DRESS CODE REMINDER - c**ondensed from 2017-18 Student Handbook For all Urbana Elementary School students, no article of clothing shall be worn that distracts from the educational process. Clothing is to be neat, clean, and modest. Please

1. Unacceptable – very short skirts and shorts, midriff tops, low-cut tops

2. Not permitted, chains and studded accessories, clothing/items with writing/symbols that relate to gangs or advertise activities against school regulations.








- 3. Students may not wear clothing or have personal belongings with writing or symbols that are obscene or suggestive of obscenities, alcohol, tobacco, or an unhealthy attitude toward school.
- 4. Hats and other head coverings not to be worn in the building, no sunglasses.
- 5. No pants or shorts with holes and no cut offs. No droopers. No sleepwear.
- 6. **No flip flops and no stacked heel shoes**, and no footwear with wheels.
