


FINALFORMS IMPLEMENTATION

Our Literacy Coaches' Reading Corner


Searching for and Using Information -Within the Text

Readers have to

look for a lot of information while reading. They use the meaning and structure of the sentences along with the way the words look in order to decode and understand the text. They also spend time looking at the non-text features such as: illustrations, photographs, diagrams, charts, glossaries, indexes, tables of contents, etc. All of these features together build meaning and understanding of the text.

One way that you can help your reader use this strategic action is by asking them questions about the text:

- What is the genre (fiction/nonfiction)? How do you know?
- Who is/are the main character(s)?
- How does the story begin/end?
- How is the problem solved?
- When and where does the story take place?
